

Key Fob Instructions

Supplies:

- **VINYL:** Cut 2, one for the front and one for the back. A piece that's roughly 3 ½ x 5 ½ will be large enough if placed diagonally across the hoop, but since Vinyl isn't cheap, you may want to use the placement stitches as a guide to only cut what you need. You can also check the stitch chart and cut each piece a bit larger than those dimensions.

Use Marine Vinyl or Glitter Vinyl that's safe for sewing. You can purchase safe Vinyl from www.mypunkbroidery.com and www.mikriworldllc.com. You can also use Marine Vinyl from JoAnns, it will be with the home decorator fabrics on the big rolls. (Vinyl is preferred, but felt can also be used.)

- **THREAD and APPLIQUE FABRIC** depending on the design: I like to use more vinyl for the appliques, but anything can be used. If you use a woven fabric, make sure you apply heat n bond.
- **SNAPS** (I use KAM Snaps)
- **Tear away STABILIZER**
- **Key Fob HARDWARE** (Rings, hook, whatever your preference is) Our designs fit the 1 inch rings and 1 inch half rings the best, the ones

that have an opening that's 1 inch across.

- **Specific STITCH CHART** (included with each design)

Hoop a piece of stabilizer.



On the hooped piece of tear away or dissolvable (water soluble) stabilizer, stitch the design outline.




Place 1 piece of vinyl right side up, make sure to cover the stitches completely. (Tape helps)

Stitch the decoration. The hedgehog is shown. Each design will stitch in the proper order. Please refer to the chart included with each design for stitch order. Filled stitch and bean stitch designs are straightforward, for applique pieces, a placement line is stitched for the fabric, and the triple stitch secures it in place. Trim after each piece. Some designs include true appliques, with a placement line, a tack down line, and finishing satin stitches.



Some designs do not have any "decorations", for those designs (which only have two steps), you'll place the back fabric at the same time as the front fabric.






After the decoration is complete, you will only have one step left on the machine.

You will place the other piece of vinyl on the **BACK** of the hoop. Then stitch it in place; (the last step).



Back:



Remove from machine and unhoop.

Tear off stabilizer. (I prefer to do this before I trim because it's easier to pull off **ALL** the stabilizer that way.)

Apply Snaps where the little circles are:



Add Key Fob Hardware.
